Skill Level: Intermediate







By using these cute edges you easily give your crochet project a lovely touch. There are so many versions of this stitch. You can choose the one that suits you best for your next crocheted item.

What do you need to crochet this project?


- Crochet hook size 2.5 mm
- Yarn:
 - o yarndage: 1.76 Oz (50g) / 185 Yrds (169m)
 - o weight: Fingering (14 wpi) / Super Fine
 - o fiber type: 100% mercerized cotton






































Basic crochet stitch

- ch chain
- sl st slip stitch
- sc single crochet
- hdc half double crochet
- dc double crochet
- chain 3 single crochet picot
